TRUTH

The LGBTQ community is perceived as one of the least welcome groups in Wichita.

DARE

Engage in a meaningful conversation with a person of a different orientation to better understand their truth.

TRUTH

42% of third graders in USD 259 have a limited ability to read at grade-level.

DARE

Commit to spending time with a child through a literacy improvement program.

Examples: Reading is Fundamental, Read to Rover, Read to Succeed

75% of neighbors say it is important to welcome new neighbors, but only 41% say they were welcomed when they moved in.

DARE

Invite a neighbor to your house for a meal.
